Society trusts that the results of research reflect an honest attempt by scientists and other researchers to describe the world accurately and without bias. But this trust will endure only if the scientific community devotes itself to exemplifying and transmitting the values associated with ethical research conduct (National Academy of Sciences, 2009). **Research ethics** is specifically interested in the analysis of ethical issues that are raised when people are involved as participants in research (Walton, 2015).
